## 2. Submission of Entries

Registration of each National Olympic Committee (NOC) must comply with the regulations of Vietnam SEA Games Organizing Committee (VIESGOC).

**2.1** Entry by Number: Deadline for submission of Entry by Number Forms is January 12, 2022 at 24:00 hours Vietnam time (GMT+7).

**2.2** Entry by Name: Deadline for submission of Entry by Name Forms is March 12, 2022 at 24:00 hours Vietnam time (GMT+7).

The completed Entry by Name must be submitted for each athlete and include all necessary information. Original form must be presented during the Delegation Registration Meeting (DRM).

## 3. Eligibility

**3.1** Participants must comply with the Law of the International Jujitsu Federation

(JJIF), the Regulations of the Southeast Asian Games Federation (SEAGF) as well as the Rule 40 and the Byelaw to the Rule 40 of the Olympic Rules (Participating in the Southeast Asian Games - SEA Games).

**3.2** Only nationals of the country of the NOC shall be qualified to represent the NOC in the Games. All disputes relating to the determination of the country, which an athlete may represent in the SEA Games shall be resolved in accordance with SEAGF Charter and Rules as well as Rule 41 and By-law to Rule 41 of the Olympic Charter (Nationality of competitors).

## **4. Doping Control**

**4.1** VIESGOC under the guidance of the SEAGF, will be responsible for the Anti-Doping Programme during the 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games. The Anti-Doping Programme will be implemented in accordance with SEAGF Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code and its relevant International Standards.

**4.2** VIESGOC and SEAGF are responsible for providing necessary conditions for Doping testing activities at the 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games. Doping Control procedures will be implemented according to WADA's International Standards for Testing and Investigations. Sample analysis will be performed at a WADA-accredited laboratory.

**4.3** Doping Control stations will be set up at the competition venue by VIESGOC, where in-competition testing will be conducted. The Test Distribution Plan and criteria for athlete selection for each sport will comply with the Doping Control protocol established by the SEAGF and WADA.

**4.4** During the Games, all athletes are subjected to for the Anti-Doping Programme that is organized by VIESGOC and SEAGF. Testing or sampling can be done at any time and place without any notice.

**4.5** The WADA 2022 List of Prohibited Substances and Methods is applied in

accordance with the WADA Code.

## 5. Approval of the Technical Handbook

This rule has been approved by the Asian Jujitsu Federation and is directed and adopted by the International Jujitsu Federation.

Adjustments and amendments to the Rule will be sent by e-mail to the NOCs.

## 6. Covid-19 Health Protocol

During the Games, the Jujitsu Competitions shall adopt the COVID-19 Epidemic control protocols approved by VIESGOC.

## 7. Competition Information

May 14 - 15, 2022

## 9. Quotas

Each National Olympic Committee will be allowed to attend a maximum of 2 male athletes in the Jujitsu (Gi), 1 male athletes in the men's Jujitsu (NO Gi) event and 2 female athletes in the women's Jujitsu (Gi), 1 female athletes in the women's Jujitsu (NO Gi) content.

Each National Olympic Committee athlete is only allowed to participate in one (01) weight class per event.

Age Limitation: The minimum age limit for athletes is 16 years old. For those athletes who have not attained their majority (legal adult age), authority from their parents should be obtained.

## 13. Competition Procedures, Rules and Regulations

### 13.1 Jujitsu Rules

The Jujitsu competition of the 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games will be held according to the current laws and regulations of the International Jujitsu Federation (IJIF) under the guidance of the Technical Director appointed by the Asian Jujitsu Federation.

In the event of any disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules and Regulations, the English version will prevail. Any unforeseen circumstances not specified in these Rules and Regulations will be handled as follows:

**13.1.1** General issues: Resolved in accordance with SEAGF Rules and Regulations.

**13.1.2** Technical issues: Resolved in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the law of JJIF.

### **13.2 Rules of disqualification**

Athletes will be disqualified if they do not follow the rules and regulations and if they are not present at the event.

### **13.3 Postpone, delay and cancellation**

The technical official and the Executive Director must consult the VIESGOC Secretariat if there is any postpone, delay or cancellation of any competition that affects the scheduled time for live broadcasts or award ceremonies.

## **14. Technical Officials, Adjudicators and Jury of Appeal**

The appointment of technical officials, international Adjudicators and the Supervisory Board will comply with the Law of the Jujitsu Federation, the Articles 41 of SEAGF Rules and Regulations.

### **14.1 International Technical Officials (ITOs)**

Technical officials, referees and members of the Competition Supervisory Board shall be certified by JJIF and appointed or recommended by TD representing JJAU.

AF/IF has the right to appoint the Technical Delegate and ITOs in coordination and approval of OCA. In case of violation of the IF/AF Rules and Games Rules and

Regulations by any participant.

The OCA has the right to revoke the AD Card and propose change of the person to the concerned party.

VIESGOC will pay for the costs of international transportation based on an economy direct-route fare, local transport, accommodation and per diem for these Technical Officials (ITOs).

Participating NOCs shall bear the international transportation cost for its nominated Technical Official while VIESGOC will bear costs related to local transport, accommodation and per diem for these Referees.

## **14.2 National Adjudicators**

The Vietnam Jujitsu Federation will designate the number of National Adjudicators reviewed and approved by VIESGOC to assist international Adjudicators.

## **14.3 Jury of Appeal**

Jury of Appeal shall consist of one (01) General Arbitrator and one (01) Chief Arbitrator / Technical Director who is a member of the Supervisory Board. The decision of the Supervisory Board is final.

# **15. Protests and Appeals**

**15.1** Technical recommendations are according to the Law of International Jujitsu Federation.

If a recommendation regarding the content occurred prior to the competition, such written recommendation must be submitted prior to the draw.

**15.2** All recommendations must be reviewed by the relevant Technical Director

who must make a decision as soon as possible. The person must state the reason for accepting / rejecting the motion.

**15.3** Written proposals must first be made and submitted by the Team Leader or Team Leader to the Technical Director after the end of the event, which must be paid to VIESGOC for a fee of USD 200 / per motion.

**15.4** NOCs who do not agree with the decisions of the Supervisory Board may make recommendations according to the SEAGF Rules and Regulations.

**15.5** Petition fee will be refunded if the Complaint is accepted; This fee will not be refunded if the motion is rejected.
