comply with the World Bodybuilding and Physique Federation (WBPF) Rules, the SEA Games Federation (SEAGF) Charter and Rules as well as Rule 40 and the By-law to Rule 40 of the Olympic Charter (Participation in the Games).

**3.2** Only nationals of the country of the NOC shall be qualified to represent the NOC in the Games. All disputes relating to the determination of the country, which an athlete may represent in the SEA Games shall be resolved in accordance with SEAGF Charter and Rules as well as Rule 41 and By-law to Rule 41 of the Olympic Charter (Nationality of competitors).

## **4. Doping Control**

**4.1** VIESGOC under the guidance of the SEAGF, will be responsible for the Anti-Doping Programme during the 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games. The Anti-Doping Programme will be implemented in accordance with SEAGF Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code and its relevant International Standards.

**4.2** VIESGOC and SEAGF are responsible for providing necessary conditions for Doping testing activities at the 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games. Doping Control procedures will be implemented according to WADA's International Standards for Testing and Investigations. Sample analysis will be performed at a WADA-accredited laboratory.

**4.3** Doping Control stations will be set up at the competition venue by VIESGOC, where in-competition testing will be conducted. The Test Distribution Plan and criteria for athlete selection for each sport will comply with the Doping Control protocol established by the SEAGF and WADA.

**4.4** During the Games, all athletes are subjected to for the Anti-Doping Programme that is organized by VIESGOC and SEAGF. Testing or sampling can be done at any time and place without any notice.

**4.5** The WADA 2022 List of Prohibited Substances and Methods is applied in

accordance with the WADA Code.

## 5. Approval of the Technical Handbook

This Charter was dated May 5 by the Asian Xiangqi Federation (AXF) and directed and approved by the World Xiangqi Federation (WXF).

Any further amendments to the Technical Handbook shall be circulated via e-mail to the NOCs.

## 6. Covid-19 Health Protocol

During the Games, the Xiangqi Competitions shall adopt the COVID-19 Epidemic control protocols approved by VIESGOC.

Each NOC can appoint a maximum of 2 male athletes; 2 female athletes in each individual event and 2 male athletes competing for each teammate, each athlete must not attend more than 2 events.

## 12. Xiangqi Rules and Competition Regulation

### 12.1 World Xiangqi Rules

12.2 The competition Swiss system with 7 rounds or Round Robin will be determined in accordance with the number of the participants and teams registered.

- The seeds according to the Asian Championship rankings in case Swiss system applied.

- System numbers are random in case Round Robin applied.

### 12.3 Competition timing

#### Standard

60 minutes + 30 seconds.

The rate of play will be 40 minutes for whole game with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one. The Players must record their moves played.

#### Rapid

15 minutes + 10 seconds.

The rate of play will be 10 minutes for whole game with an increment of 5 seconds per move starting from move one.

### **Blitz**

5 minutes + 2 seconds.

The rate of play will be 5 minutes for whole game with an increment of 2 seconds per move starting from move one.

## **12.4 Determining the placing of the players**

The following tie-breaking measures would be used in the orders given below:

### **Single Round Robin**

Neustadt score, encounter, higher number of wins, higher number of wins as Black, more games as Black, direct encounter with Black, lesser number of technical fouls.

### **Swiss System with one game per round**

Sum of opponent's Score, the result of their direct encounter, higher number of wins, higher number of wins as Black, more games as Black, highest placing of the player's opponent, lesser number of technical fouls.

## **12.5 Determining the placing of the team**

### **Round Robin Tournaments**

Number of points , the Sum of the individual scores, Neustadt (the sum of the opponent's scores round scores; and the half of opponent's round scores), more wins, higher number of the individual wins, direct encounter, fist board, more games as Black, lesser number of technical fouls.

## **Team tournament Swiss System**

Sum of opponent's Round Scores, the Sum of the individual scores, direct encounter, the sum of the individual scores of their opponents, the highest individual scores of fist board, the number of times the team played Black, the lesser number of technical fouls

## **12.6 General matters**

General matters are resolved in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Sports Council of Southeast Asia.

## **12.7 Competition outfit**

The competition uniform used by the athletes during the match must comply with the rules of the SEAGF Rules and Regulations.

## **13. Technical Officials, Referees, Competition Supervision Board**

The appointment of members to the Delegation of Technical Officials, International Arbitration and the Supervisory Board will be in accordance with Article 41 of the SEAGF Rules and Regulations.

## **14. Jury of Appeal**

The Chairman and Board members will be selected before the start of the competition.

## **15. Protests and Appeals**

Opposing the referee's decision will be complained within 15 minutes of the game ending or before the draw.

**15.1** Complaints must be filed with 200 USD to the Organizer. If the complaint is correct, the organizers will refund the money. If the complaint is wrong, this amount will be collected to the Organizing Committee.

**15.2** Complaints by athlete or team leader.
