PARTICIPATION	Only NOCs not sanctioned by the ISSA and NSFs not sanctioned, and recognized, by WB may enter athletes in the Riyadh 2025 Islamic Solidarity Games. NFs need to be fully recognized by the time the registration finishes.

ATHLETE QUOTA	Male Female Total	60 60 120
ALLOCATION OF SLOTS	Athlete slots are allocated to the NOC, not to individual athletes.	
MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NOC	An NOC may allocate a maximum of ten (10) athletes, five (5) male and five (5) female athletes. Plus reserve boxers.	
ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY	- Elite Boxers from recognized NFs from World Boxing - Holders of a WB Record Book - In compliance with all WB regulations, including but not limited, World Boxing Anti Doping Code.(https://worldboxing.org/wp-content/uploads/2025/02/World-Boxing-Anti-Doping-WADA-2025-01-20-rules-updated.pdf	
MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NOC	NOCs may enter a maximum of one (1) athlete per individual event as main boxer, plus 1 reserve per event.	
ALLOCATION SYSTEM PRINCIPLES		
METHOD	DESCRIPTION	TOTAL
NOC ALLOCATION	WB will allocate 55 male and 55 female athlete slots, following a criteria based WB Ranking points, previous participation in Games (ex:Olympic Games,), with the goal of fulfilling universality representation. As the total number of boxers is capped in general, and there is no classification process, NFs are required to rank the priority of their respective boxers in order for them to be selected following a round system, based on availability per weight category.	55 male athletes 55 female athletes
