ALLOCATION SYSTEM PRINCIPLES		
METHOD	DESCRIPTION	TOTAL
	The LOC, will allocate 46 athlete quotas at its discretion, with a maximum of 4 athletes per NOC.	
NOC ALLOCATION	In the event of over-registration (i.e., more than 46 athletes registered), the number of entries per NOC will be reduced to 3 in order to ensure the total number does not exceed the 46 allocated quotas.	46
	If over-registration persists after this adjustment, the entry limit may be further reduced to 2 athletes per NOC to guarantee the quota cap is respected.	

Host Country Allocation	The Host Country will be allocated a direct quota of four (4) athletes to participate in the ISG Riyadh 2025.	4
