ALLOCATION OF SLOTS	Athlete slots are allocated to the NOC, not to individual athletes.
MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NOC	Each NOC may allocate a maximum of twelve (12) athletes, across all weight categories with a maximum of two (2) athletes per weight category. The selection should be up to five (5) men and seven (7) women.  The selection of the participants will be done by the organisers/IJF considering the IJF Senior World Ranking List of 29 September 2025.  The selection criteria will be based on best athletes, gender equality, universality (when possible one (1) athlete per country per gender) to reach an even number of participants per category.  Deadline for long list submission: 26 August 2025  Deadline for selection of participants: TBC  Reallocations deadline not earlier than: TBC  The IJF Senior World Ranking List of 03 November 2025 will be used for seeding during the Games draw.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY	IF Nationality Regulations World Antidoping Code IJF Sport and Organisation Rules, IJF Referee Rules
AGE REQUIREMENTS	Athletes must be born on or before 31 December 2010.
MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NOC	NOCs are permitted to participate with up to two (2) athletes per weight category.
MIXED TEAM EVENT	All athletes who qualify in the individual competition can take part in the mixed team event. Exception to IJF rule: a NOC is eligible to take part in the mixed team event with a minimum of athletes that can fulfil 4 (four) categories.
