ALLOCATION SYSTEM PRINCIPLES		
METHOD	DESCRIPTION	TOTAL
JJIF WORLD RANKING ALLOCATION	JJIF will allocate 116 male and female athlete slots combined at its discretion based on NOC/NSF participation in the JJIF events and on the JJIF World Ranking List, Universality and Home Nation. Every event category shall have a minimum of 12 entries. More entry options will be assigned to the event categories with the highest number of registrations. At least 8 of 12 slots per category are assigned according to the JJIF World Ranking list.	60-68 male athletes 48-56 female athletes
NOC allocation	Each NOC can register up to 9 athletes. If there are more registrations than assigned competition	Up to 5 male
