ALLOCATION OF ATHLETE SLOTS	Athlete slots are allocated to the NOC's individual athletes.
ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY	<p>To be eligible for entry, an athlete must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold an active World Para Athletics Licence for the 2025 season as well as meeting all eligibility requirements set out in Regulation 4.2 of the World Para Athletics Rules & Regulations. • Hold a sport class status of 'Review' (R) or 'Confirmed' (C). • Must rank within the indicated ranking position below ('Target Number'). The official rankings for Riyadh 2025 can be found on the website of WPA (Minimum Entry Standard Rankings > Riyadh 2025 6th Islamic Solidarity Games). In a case of an NOC not accepting the slot for the athlete, the next athlete inline will qualify. The same method will be used for an NOC with 3 or more athletes within the Target Number. <p>Qualification period: 01 January 2024 – 23 September 2025.</p>

MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NOC	NOCs may enter a maximum of two (2) athletes per individual event.

NOC Athlete Allocation by Ranking	To be eligible for selection by an NOC, athletes must rank within the indicated ranking position below. The official rankings for Riyadh 2025 can be found on the website of WPA (Minimum Entry Standard Rankings > Riyadh 2025 6th Islamic Solidarity Games).	32 male athletes 32 female athletes
Host City Allocation	In the case of the host nation (Saudi Arabia) not qualifying through the above 'NOC Athlete Allocation by Ranking' method for an event, the host will be presented with an additional slot. If the host should accept this additional slot, they will be able to qualify 1 (one) additional athlete in this event on the approval of WPA Management Team and the Technical Delegate. The athlete must meet the above 'Athlete Eligibility' with a valid WPA License and a valid sport class status.
