NOC ALLOCATION	WT will allocate 66 male and 66 female athlete slots at its discretion based on the World Taekwondo Ranking list of July, published in	66 male athletes
	August and include universality principle at its discretion. WT will provide the LOC with a list of qualified athletes by no later than 20 August.	66 female athletes
HOST COUNTRY	The Host Country has maximum 6 quota places for the male medal events and 6 quota places	6 male athletes
QUOTA	for the female medal events.	6 female athletes
