<b>ALLOCATION OF ATHLETE SLOTS</b>	Athlete slots are allocated to the NOC, not to individual athletes.
<b>MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NOC</b>	<p>A NOC may be allocated a maximum of eight (8) individual male athlete quota slots and eight (8) individual female athlete quota slots.</p> <p>If the number of registered athletes exceeds the 240 available quota places after the Final Entries deadline, the Islamic Solidarity Sports Association (ISSA) and the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) reserve the right to limit the number of athletes per National Olympic Committee (NOC). Priority will first be given to the host country, followed by ensuring universality, gender balance, and performance.</p>
<b>ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY</b>	<p>IF Nationality Regulations</p> <p>IWF Anti-doping Rules will apply.</p> <p>Anti-doping / Whereabouts requirements: In accordance with article 5.5.16 of the IWF Anti-Doping Rules whereabouts information of the athletes shall be submitted at minimum three (3) months prior to the event (Q3 / by 07 August 2025 &amp; Q4 / by 30 September 2025).</p> <p>Minimum Age Requirements: According to the IWF Technical &amp; Competition Rules and Regulations (IWF</p>

	TCRR), the participating athletes must be 15 years of age and over (year of birth 2010 or earlier).
<b>MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NOC</b>	NOCs may enter a maximum of one (1) athlete per individual event.
<b>AWARDS</b>	Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded in the Snatch, the Clean & Jerk, and the Total in each bodyweight category.

<b>NOC ALLOCATION</b>	<p>Every National Olympic Committee (NOC), whose National Federation is affiliated with the Islamic Solidarity Sports Association (ISSA) and the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF), will participate in the competition with a team of a maximum of 16 athletes.</p> <p>A maximum of eight (8) athletes can participate in the men's events, but a maximum of one (1) athlete per event</p> <p>A maximum of eight (8) athletes can participate in the women's events, but a maximum of one (1) athlete per event.</p>	<p>120 male athletes</p> <p>120 female athletes</p>
