ALLOCATION SYSTEM PRINCIPLES

METHOD	DESCRIPTION	TOTAL
NOC ALLOCATION	UWW will allocate 72 male and 72 female athlete slots at its discretion based on NOC/NSF participation in the UWW Ranking series events, regional representation on the UWW World Ranking List, universality and Home Nation.	72 male athletes
	Athlete entries will be confirmed after the conclusion of the Senior World Championships on September 21st, following these key principles:	72 female athletes

- the top **nine (9)** athletes from the 2025 Rankings.
- Two (2) athletes from unqualified regions. If a continent is unrepresented, the highest-ranked athlete from that continent will qualify. If all continents are represented, the spots will be allocated to the next best ranked NOC not yet qualified.
- One (1) athlete from the host country

Any unused quota will be reallocated to the next best ranked athlete from the Ranking published after the 2025 Senior World Championships.

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country must participate in at least one international competition that counts for the UWW Ranking Series to validate its allocated spot for the Games.

If the host country fails to meet this requirement in a specific weight category, the reserved spot will be reallocated to the next best ranked athletes not yet qualified.
