ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION	Athlete slots are allocated to the NOC, not to individual athletes.
MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NOC	An NOC may allocate a maximum of 6 athletes (3 male and 3 female).
AGE REQUIREMENTS	Age 18-40. Athletes must be born between 1 January 1985 and 31 December 2007.
ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY	IF Nationality Regulations World Antidoping Code IWUF Wushu Sanda Competition Rules and Judging Methods
MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NOC	NOCs may enter a maximum of 1 athlete per weight category.

ALLOCATION SYSTEM PRINCIPLES

METHOD	DESCRIPTION	TOTAL
NOC ALLOCATION	IWUF will allocate 38 male and 38 female athlete slots at its discretion, based on NSF participation in IWUF world championships (including activity level, performance, and good standing). In case of over-quota registration, IWUF will reallocate slots fairly, prioritizing universality. Additionally, one quota per event is reserved for the host country (Saudi Arabia).	38 male athletes 38 female athletes

The Riyadh 2025 Islamic Solidarity Games Wushu competition will be included in IWUF Calendar and will be considered for selection in the IWUF annual outstanding athletes and coaches program.
